APPLICATION PROCESS

Step 1 – Nominations:

We kindly ask all partner institutions to confirm to us by email (dprendon@ujaen.es) their ERASMUS nominations/selection of outgoing students stating their full name, student ID number, study programme and period of stay at the University of Jaén.

Step 2 – Applications:

All exchange students are required to submit a **Formal Application.** They must:

- [1] Fill in (and also click on the Send button) our Exchange Students Application Form,
- [2] After clicking on the *Send* button <u>print it and give it to the persons in charge in the home</u> <u>University for signing and official stamping</u> (*Home Institution Information* Section), and
 - [3] <u>Send it</u> by regular post (not by email, nor by fax) together with your [a] home university original transcript of records [b] identity card copy (page with photo only) to this address:

Regarding the UJA Application Form (first online and then as printed copy), please make sure that you have filled in all the required information, including your photograph (identity card size). All the information requested in the Application Form is mandatory, except that concerning languages other than Spanish.

Step 3 – Admission Letters:

After receiving the dully signed and stamped applications by regular post, the International Office will forward them to the student Academic Coordinator and the International Mobility Coordinator. After acceptance, the students will receive an official letter of acceptance and additional information about housing and other facilities.

APPLICATIONS DEADLINES

First semester or Full Academic Year students:

before 30th June 2013 for EU nationals

Second semester students:

Before 31st May for non EU nationals or

Before 30th November 2013
